FEES:

1. The **annual membership dues** of \$70 per school (per gender) is due immediately; checks made payable to **NEPSwim** and sent to: **Keith Moon**, NEPSSA Vice President, CO The Hotchkiss School PO Box 800 Lakeville, CT 06039
2. Meet **entry fees** payable to **NEPSwim** should also be sent to **Keith Moon**:
 - a. Individual events (entered, not swum): \$3.00/event
 - b. Relay events (entered, not swum): \$7.00/ relay team (\$14.00 for A and B relays)

ENTRIES:

3. All swimming entries and completed diving sheets are due by 2pm on Monday, Feb. 17. Any number of entries may be made in individual events but must be scratched down to **FOUR** entries per team per event by the scratch deadline (Wednesday, Feb. 26). **PLEASE NOTE that only THREE entries will be allowed to advance and score .** Any number of competitors may be entered in either the A or B relays at \$7.00 per relay entered.
4. Relay cards will be given to the coaches prior to the finals so that the names of the swimmers actually swimming in the relay events may be submitted to the head table. Be sure to deliver the card to the table, as this will be the only record of who will swim in the relay. Relay cards improperly submitted or not submitted will result in the disqualification of the relay.

ENTRY BLANKS:

1. Use Hytek Meet Manager and return directly to John Liller. (john.liller@worcesteracademy.org), Meet Entry Coordinator, by the deadline. See the league website for the meet entries file and/or Hytek Meet Manager Lite for those teams not yet using the program.
2. All times submitted should have been accomplished during the 2013-2014 season in interscholastic competition and recorded in short course yards. It is essential that coaches take care to be accurate to the .00 decimal.
3. For meter swims, convert according to the accepted meter conversion table in the 2013-2014 Federation Rule Book.
4. We are publishing once again a list of “suggested cut off times” for all teams to use at their discretion and as appropriate (please see the end of this document). The coaches in the league have agreed to respect each team’s decision in regard to their entries, understanding that we are acting in good faith, balancing competing desires and needs.
5. In the interest of the best possible competition, fairness, and integrity, all submitted times should be the fastest times achieved in N.E.P.S.S.A. official league competition and during the winter 2013-2014 interscholastic season.

PSYCHE SHEETS:

This year we are once again allowing the entry of two relay teams per school. The B relay cannot score points but will allow swimmers who do not ordinarily swim at night to be part of the excitement of finals. Please be careful to distinguish the A and B relay times. Any relay submitted without a time will be entered at “No Time.” You may enter as many swimmers as you wish.

NOTE: The 200 yard medley relays, 500 yard freestyle, 200 free relays, and 400 free relays are all timed final events. All relays are swum in the evening sessions only. Those swimmers seeded slower than the 16th seeded swimmer in the 500 yard freestyle will swim in the trials session only, but their times will qualify them in place according to all the times swum in the event, afternoon and evening. The top sixteen seeded swimmers in the 500 yard freestyle will swim in the finals session only. Final placement will be determined when the entire event has been contested.

ELIGIBILITY:

The meet is open to any swimmer or diver attending a member school of the New England Preparatory School Swimming Association (NEPSSA). **Membership in NEPSSA is defined using the following three criteria:**

1. The school must be a member of NEPSAC.
2. The school must have a varsity swim program.
3. The swim program must have competed against two (2) other NEPSSA member teams.

DIVING COMPETITION:

Division III Divers will compete all eleven dives on Friday, February 28, 2014, at Canterbury School. Each team is allowed three entries per gender. Team points in the diving event will be awarded based upon the order of finish. After FIVE rounds of competition, the number of divers in each division will be cut to the top 20 in each gender, and after EIGHT rounds, the number of competitors in each division will be cut to the top 16.

The final 16 divers will compete their last THREE rounds of dives. Dive coaches will help score the diving event. A diving referee will also be present.

DIVING ENTRIES:

Diving entries should be entered in to eDive. Please follow this link. <http://www.edive.info/emailentries.aspx>. For the email. The meet host email is: Cburyswimming@gmail.com. The name of the meet is **DIII NEPPSA Championships**. Please use this form only. A standardized format will help the efficiency of the scoring table. Any changes may occur on deck during warm-up as long as they are made 30 minutes prior to the beginning of the trials. Dives and diving sheets must be in accordance with the specifications for championship competition in the National High School Federation 2013-2014 rule book.

COACHES' MEETING:

There will be a coaches' meeting in the pool office prior to the start of both the swimming trials and finals.

RULES:

2013-2014 *National Federation of State High School Associations Swimming & Diving* rules will govern the meet.

SCORING & AWARDS:

The top sixteen finishers will be awarded points toward the team scoring as follows:

Only three athletes per event per team will be allowed to advance to finals and score.

Medals will be awarded to the top 3 finishers and ribbons to the fourth through sixteenth-place finishers in relay and individual events. Team trophies will be awarded to the winner and runner-up teams in each division.

The Babcock and Robertson Awards will be awarded to the male and female competitors, respectively, receiving the most votes from the head coaches at each of the divisional meets. **IT IS VITAL TO HAVE 100% OF THE COACHES VOTE ON THESE AWARDS!**

TIMERS AND WATCHES:

Each participating school is expected to furnish three timers each day. They will be called for at the appropriate time on the pool deck. It is assumed that the designated timers will be present for both the trials and the finals.

Each participating school is also expected to provide stop watches calibrated to 1/100 of a second before the start of the swimming trials each day. Please put your school's name on the back of each watch and retrieve these watches at the conclusion of the meet.

A separate sheet of lane assignments and times will be posted as the meet draws closer.

MEALS: Team lunches will be available for Saturday in the Dining Hall. Please see attached order form. This must be mailed in by February 20, 2014. There will be concessions and there are a number of local restaurants in the New Milford Area.

T-SHIRTS, MEET PROGRAMS, & CONCESSIONS will be for sale in the lobby of the William W. Higgins '53 Aquatic Center at Canterbury School.

COACHES' INFORMATION PACKETS: May be picked up on the pool deck beginning at 7:00 A.M. Saturday.

LOCKERS, RAZORS, TOWELS, SECURITY, DECK SPACE, & SAFETY:

- Only athletes and coaches are permitted in the locker rooms and on the pool deck.
- Towels will not be available.
- Razors and shaving cream are prohibited in the locker rooms and on the pool deck.
- Lockers will be available on a first-come-first serve basis. No locks will be provided.
- Neither Canterbury School nor NEPSA is responsible for lost or stolen valuables or clothing, as locker room and gym areas cannot be fully secured.
- Deck space is very limited and seating is tight. We will have metal bleachers and team benches on the deck, some with sharp edges that could cause lacerations. Athletes are advised to use caution when moving around on the deck.
- Absolutely no glass containers to be brought into the pool area.
- No food is to be brought on deck and absolutely no valuables should be left anywhere.
- We ask that teams and spectators abide by the host school's campus security's special directions for parking and traffic circulation this weekend.
- Spectator bathrooms are available for spectators in the upstairs of the William W. Higgins '53 Aquatic Center.

PARKING:

- Team vans and busses may drop-off in front of the Aquatic and Athletic Center. After athletes are dropped off, van- and bus-drivers will be directed to parking areas.
- All spectators will be directed by a security to park in the Elkington Farm Lot and other overflow lots; see attached campus map.)

- Please note that the pool will NOT be available for swimming warm up on Friday, February 28.
